Nature of Appointment

Eligibility Criteria

The qualifications and eligibility shall be as per the norms prescribed by the University Grants Commission (UGC), Government of Maharashtra, and the University of Mumbai. Candidates must possess a master's degree in social work (MSW) with at least 55% marks (or an equivalent grade) from a recognised University. Additionally, NET / SET qualification is also mandatory.

- Institutional and Administrative Responsibilities: Participate in all college activities, committees allocated, extension programs, documentation, and other academic or administrative duties assigned by the Principal


Application Process
