# Objective

## Business Pitch

To empower aspiring entrepreneurs by providing a platform to pitch their innovative ideas, with a focus on both social impact and profit generation, and receive valuable feedback from experts.

## Idea Hackathon

To inspire collaboration and innovation among participants as they develop creative solutions to real-world social challenges, fostering ideas that have the potential to create meaningful impact.



# ● Competition Guidelines

## Business Pitch

- All participants will be provided with a table or easel to present their posters on.
- Props may be used as needed for visual aid.
- During open session: Students will "pitch" their ideas/posters to public.
- Students will give a 3-minutes final pitch to judges.
- Contestants should dress appropriately
- Poster information should include
  - Business Idea/ Business Name
  - Who (target market), What (benefits), When (ROI), Where (online?) & How (differentiation)
- All posters will be 36" by 48," Portrait
- Must be visually attractive with charts, pictures & graphs

# ● Competition Guidelines

## Idea Hackathon

- In the first stage, a **CONCEPT PAPER** is required to be submitted to [yadnesh.cswnn@gmail.com](mailto:yadnesh.cswnn@gmail.com) by 8th September, 2025.
- In the second stage, all those who have send concept note shall be invited for interaction with jury on 17th September, 2025 at 2:00 pm.
- A title of less than 20 words.
- A summary of 300 words summarising your arguments.
- Keep a title page where you include
  - a) title of the entry;
  - b) and names of authors and their affiliating educational institutions, including contact details of email and phone numbers.
- Include an introduction/background (around 750 words).
- A section of methods/process (less than 500 words).
- Main body of your paper clearly demarcating sub-sections using sub headings (about 2000 words).
- Conclusion (less than 500 words).
- List of references you may have used.

## Idea Hackathon Topic

**E-waste**, or electronic waste, includes discarded devices like mobile phones, laptops, and appliances. In India, it falls under the E-Waste (Management) Rules, 2022, separate from general waste, due to its hazardous nature, containing toxic substances like lead and mercury. In 2020-21, India generated 1.71 million tonnes of e-waste, ranking third globally after China and the USA, but only 22.7% was formally processed. Much of it is managed informally, with unsafe practices that threaten health and environmental safety. Key challenges include low public awareness, lack of collection centers, weak enforcement of regulations, and no incentives for recycling. **What ideas can be implemented to tackle these e-waste management challenges and significantly reduce e-waste in India?**

## Rules

- Any student registered for an under-graduate or post graduate program.
- Both individual submission and group submissions are eligible. Students may form a team of maximum up to three students.
- One student / team could submit only one entry.
- Final authority for settling any disputes arising out of competition shall be the jury of eminent scholars appointed by organisers.

## Judging Criteria

- Innovation (25%)
- Scalability of solution (25%)
- Ability to articulate idea based on evidence (25%)
- Interdisciplinary (25%)
