## Instructions for BSW Aptitude Test 2026-27

1. All candidates who have applied for BSW admissions 2026-27 will appear for the written aptitude test. It will be conducted offline at College of Social Work, Nirmala Niketan, Churchgate campus on 05<sup>th</sup> June 2026 from 10am-1pm. Candidates are requested to reach the venue by 9:30am latest and be seated in the exam hall by 9:45am.
2. The aptitude test is divided into 3 sections: General knowledge, case interpretation and English.
3. All candidates must bring any one **original government ID** form the following: PAN card, Adhaar card, driving license, passport. **Xeroxes are not permitted.**
4. All candidates must bring the following **original documents** on 5<sup>th</sup> June for physical verification with **2 copies of each**:
  - 1) SSC Marksheet and Passing Certificate
  - 2) HSC Marksheet and Passing Certificate
  - 3) Migration Certificate (Students outside Maharashtra Board)
