**Number of Participants: 130.**

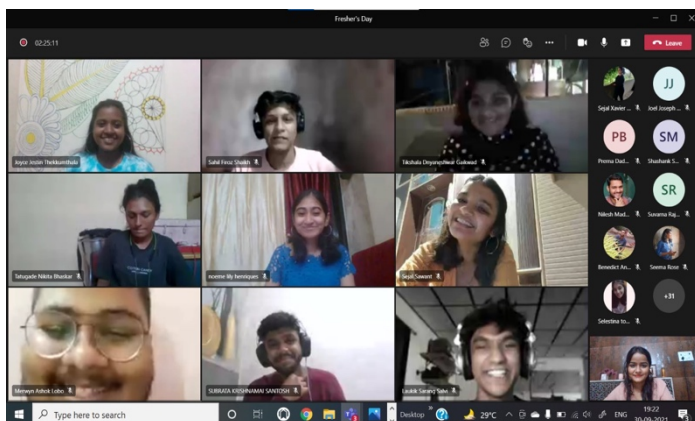
