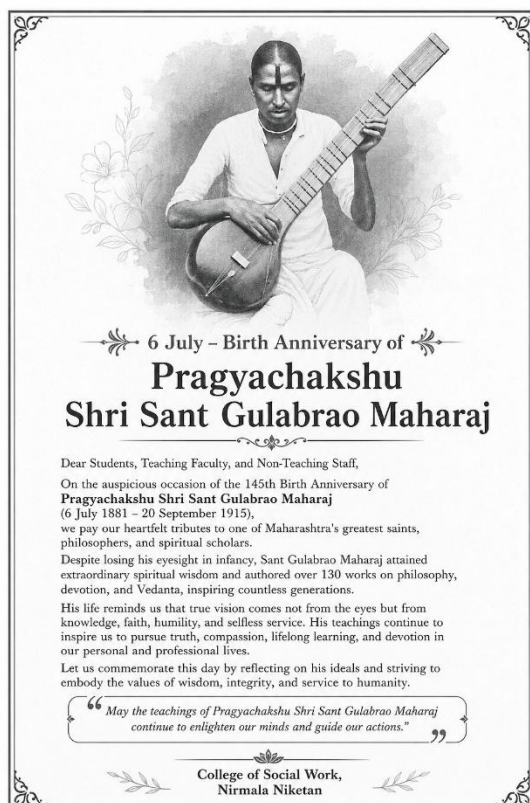


Report on the Observance of the Birth Anniversary of Sant Gulabrao Maharaj

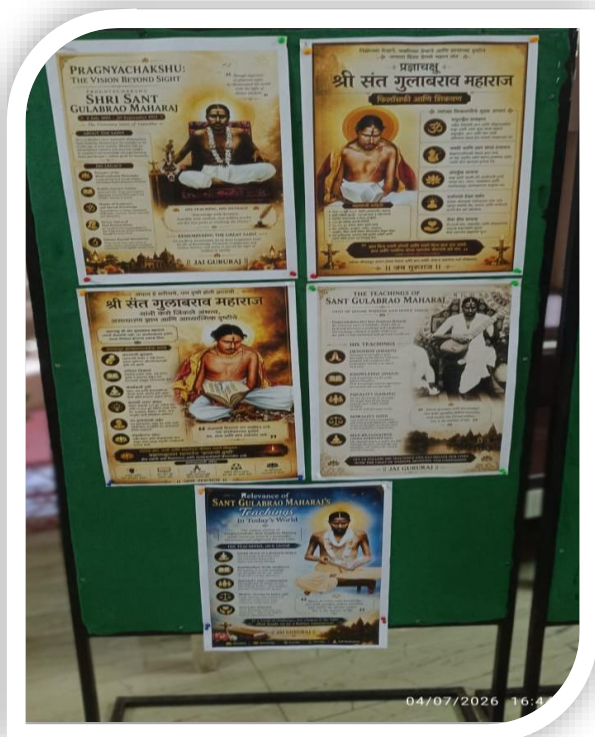
