The College has a history of responding to natural and human made disasters occurring in different parts of the country. August 29, 2017 saw a near repeat of July 26, 2005 like situation in Mumbai as the city received rainfall in excess of 330 mm. The train services at Central, Harbour and Western Railways came to a halt resulting in a number of people being stranded at various stations.

Our College provided free food and stay to its own staff members and over 150 citizens stranded in the nearby offices and Churchgate station. Simple arrangements were made for the overnight stay of citizens at the first floor hall, classrooms and also the hall of College of Home Science
