

MA Social Innovation and Entrepreneurship Admission Policy 2022

- The *MA Social Innovation and Entrepreneurship* curriculum consists of relevant aspects of both theory and field internship to help students enhance their practical understanding of social innovation and entrepreneurship practice.
- The need to provide individualized facilitation demands that a relatively small number of students are admitted to MA program. Seats in *MA Social Innovation and Entrepreneurship* is 40
- There is no minimum age for admission provided the student meets all other eligibility and admission criteria required by the University and the College. Admission is open to men, women and other gender students for all programs.
- English is the medium of instruction. Hence, the ability to use English as a language is essential for this program.
- Check the following Program Eligibility Norms before starting your Application:
 1. Candidates aspiring for the *MA Social Innovation and Entrepreneurship* admission should have completed Graduation (10+2+3) from any of the UGC approved University in India or AIU approved foreign universities.
 2. The minimum percentage for marks at the Graduation Course for eligibility to MA admission process is 40%
 3. The Candidates applying from University other than University of Mumbai have to follow eligibility process subscribed by the University of Mumbai.
- Application Procedure
 1. Application forms are invited for MA programs only through ONLINE mode.
 2. Applicant has to apply online in the admission portal given in the College website.
 3. There is NO application fee for this program
 4. After checking the application form, all eligible candidates shall be called for Group Discussion and Panel Interviews (50 Marks)
 5. Post the interview, shortlisted candidates shall be offered admission
 6. Students whose names are declared in the merit list should secure admission by paying the fees within the time and date specified. If they do not pay the fees and secure admission as per the first merit list date and time, they will not be considered further.
 7. Admissions will be considered to be completed only when the full fees for the academic year are paid (against an official receipt) and the name of the applicant appears on the relevant rolls.
 8. All admissions are valid only for one year and are therefore to be renewed for each subsequent year of study.
