




Total Forms Filled by Parents

Quality of Questions


- The questions in the parent feedback form were designed with clarity and purpose.

- These items reflect the intended **Program Outcomes (POs)** and are phrased in language accessible to a non-academic audience, such as parents.
- There was a high level of alignment with the **MSW program's** educational objectives.

Key features of quality:


- 1.Clear alignment with POs.

Suggestions and Areas for Improvement


- 1.Communicate student achievements in communication skills and lifelong learning more clearly (e.g., through newsletters or open houses).

Conclusion


