



- **Programme** or “Programme of study” means a higher education programme pursued for a degree specified by the Commission under sub -section (3) of section 22 of the Act
- **Course** is a subject within a Programme.
- **Credit** is a standard method of calculating learning done (directly or indirectly) per week for a duration of a semester (15 weeks) resulting in the award of one credit
- **Credit-accumulation** means the facility created by Academic Bank of Credits in the Academic Bank Account opened by students in order to transfer and consolidate the credits earned by them by undergoing Courses
- **Credits-recognition** means the credits earned through a registered Higher Educational Institution and transferred directly to the Academic Bank of Credits by such Higher Educational Institution
- **Credit-redemption** means the process of commuting the accrued credits in the Academic Bank Account of the students maintained in ABC for the purpose of fulfilling the credits requirements for the award of Degrees or Diplomas or Certificates or Course work for Ph.D. programme etc., by the registered degree-awarding Higher Educational Institutions
- **Credit-transfer** means the mechanism by which the Registered Higher Educational Institutions are able to receive or provide prescribed credits to individual

# College Process in Nutshell

- Create APAAR ID (Student)
- Provide APAAR ID in College Application Form/ MIS
- Mobile number of Aadhar should be your own (not parents' number). So first make changes in Aadhar. Otherwise, ABC credits transfer/ accumulation will be difficult.
- Complete all your internal and external assessments
- College Exam Cell will supply the details of marks and credits to the ABC Implementation Cell which will work on **Credits-recognition** by collaborating with NAD Team at Government of India
- Nodal Officer will help in **Credit-redemption** or **Credit-transfer** as per individual student needs
