

Field Work Experience at Nirmala Niketan

Field Work Practicum is an integral part of the Social Work curriculum and pedagogy at the College of Social Work, Nirmala Niketan. It is designed to orient and expose students to various social problems that lead to marginalization and oppression while enabling them to critically analyse the interventions of organizations working to address these issues. Through fieldwork, students integrate classroom learning with real-world practice, gaining experience and developing professional competence. In line with Hamilton and Else's (1983) definition, fieldwork is seen as a consciously planned set of experiences in a practice setting that helps students progress from their initial level of understanding, skills, and attitudes to those associated with autonomous professional social work practice (Dhemba, 2012). The learning model focuses on three key components: factual knowledge of theories and social issues, problemsolving and intervention skills, and self-reflection to cultivate awareness and professional ethics (Rao, 2020). Reflection is emphasized throughout as a core skill for professional growth.

The fieldwork structure includes student induction and orientation, concurrent and continuous fieldwork alongside classroom sessions, rural camps or study tours for exposure to grassroots realities, and final-year block placements for MSW students or on-the-job training (OJT) for BSW students. For MSW students, fieldwork offers specialization-based training in areas such as health (program planning, networking, health education, psychosocial interventions), community development (leadership building, resource mobilization, advocacy, project management), and child and family welfare (counselling, family-cantered interventions, casework, and child protection). This prepares them for advanced roles involving independent, real-life interventions. For BSW students, fieldwork is systematically spread across six semesters to build foundational skills for grassroots engagement and culminates in final-year OJT, connecting them with organizations and enhancing their career readiness. As a result, MSW graduates are prepared for advanced practice in specialized fields, while BSW graduates are equipped to respond to changing social realities as community organizers, development workers, and program officers.

This comprehensive and experiential approach ensures that graduates emerge as socially committed, professionally competent, and practice-ready social workers, embodying the core values and vision of the profession.

FIELD ACTION PROJECTS

YOUTH DEVELOPMENT CENTRE



It started in 1997, with the objectives of mobilising youth and raising their social consciousness to equip them with skills of social responsibility and self-awareness. It aspires to build a cadre of youth leaders. Anubhav conducts training programmes, exposure visits, camps, and exchange programmes to meet its objectives and make youth responsible citizens.

SPANDAN

In June-July 2016, child deaths from malnutrition in Talasari block, Palghar district, highlighted tribal severe malnutrition. The Talasari local partnered with government the College of Social Work to implement a project in Savroli, Dongari, and Anvir villages (25 hamlets). The project aimed to promote balanced diet awareness, improve tribal children's health, mothers' and caregivers' enhance knowledge, assess changes through research, and collaborate with agencies government to reduce malnutrition.



FIELD ACTION PROJECTS

SAKSHAM

The College of Social Work (Autonomous), Nirmala Niketan, Mumbai, has an MoU with the Tata Institute of Social Sciences as a Sub-Sub Recipient (SSR) to combat AIDS and TB under Saksham SSR Regional Institute for Capacity Building and Evaluation (RICE). Funded by the Global Fund (GFTAM), the projects Saksham Pramaan and Saksham Pravaah operate under the National AIDS Control Program and National TB Elimination Program, Ministry of Health, GoI. TISS is the Sub-Recipient (SR), and the College implements these projects in the West Zone covering Goa, Karnataka, and Maharashtra.



PRAVAAS



Pravaas (a field action project of the College of Social Work, Nirmala Niketan, Mumbai) is committed to utilize integrated social work intervention through systematically working with client system, i.e older adults, and addressing target/ change agent systems namely families, communities, and policy environments to tackle aging related social exclusion. At present, Pravaas team works in three slums, namely Bhagat Singh Nagar, Chatrapati Vasahat, and Indira Nagar in Goregaon West (Mumbai).

SOME FIELD ACTION PROJECTS NOW OPERATING AS INDEPENDENT NGOS

Family Service Centre (FSC)

FSC was set up to provide professional services to families in need in 1959. Its overarching goal was to preserve and strengthen the family and it was a pioneering agency in non-institutional services for children through adoption, foster care and sponsorship. Up to today, the Family Service Centre (now an independent NGO) continues its vision of keeping families together and has expanded its mission to include the empowerment of women in slums as well as fisherfolk communities in Mumbai.

Youth for Unity and Voluntary Action (YUVA)

YUVA emerged in 1983. This project was effective in influencing state policy on housing. The organisation actively advocated the causes of displaced slum dwellers and worked for their rehabilitation. Today YUVA (an independent NOG) has received international recognition for its work on child labour and advocacy for implementing social policies. YUVA introduced a people's planning model in creating a city based movement against oppression of the poor (www.yuvaindia.org).

Prerna

In July 1985, Prerna began work in Kamatipura, the red-light district of Mumbai. The overarching goal of the project was to safeguard the lives and rights of the children of sex workers. It began with providing nightcare services to the children of women and became an autonomous agency in 1985. It is now working with commercially-sexually exploited women and their children to prevent second-generation trafficking and exploitation and has innovative programmes for the children of women who are sexually exploited.

SOME FIELD ACTION PROJECTS NOW OPERATING AS INDEPENDENT NGOS

Nirman

Nirman, the Construction Workers' project, was an offshoot of a student placement in mobile crèches, wherein it was found that there was need for more direct intervention in construction workers' problems than merely focusing on the needs of their children. Nirman was initiated in 1985 with the aim of working with unorganised construction workers, to advocate for their rights as workers and create access to services that they were otherwise unaware of or denied. The issues tackled at the nakas (street corners) included police harassment and inter-group disputes through collaborative talks, public meetings, raising awareness of existing laws and formation of a core group to strategize the formation of a Sanghatan

Sakhya

Project Sakhya was initiated by the Divisional Office of Social Welfare under the Collector of Bombay in 1986 to work against the practice of dowry in the city. In addition to responding to individual cases of dowry harassment, the cell was also called upon to respond to a wider set of problems affecting women in the city, such as marital problems, sexual abuse, unregulated work hours, shelter needs, and legal aid. Specific activities included counselling, legal aid, and socioeconomic rehabilitation. Gradually, Sakhya joined the larger women's movement on various contextual issues.


