Field Work is an integral part of the training programme in social work. It comprises learning professional social work practice under the guidance of trained field instructors in selected Government and Non-Government organizations. It is both goal-oriented to solve a particular problem to which the student addresses his / her activities and learner-centered in relation to his / her particular interest areas and aptitudes. Field work has the dual purpose of promoting the student's own learning while contributing to the development of the people with whom he / she works, especially the disadvantaged sections of our society.

The college has been awarded the grade of academic excellence by the National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) constituted by the University Grants Commission, New Delhi, with the FIVE STAR status for its academic excellence in 2001. On 31st March 2007, the same body, after further inspection and appraisal re-accredited the College of Social Work at the A+ level with an Institutional Score of 93 per cent. The College of Social Work, Nirmala Niketan is reaccredited (Third Cycle) by the NAAC with A Grade (3.53 CGPA out of 4) in May 2015 valid up to 2024.

On 12th Feb 2019 The University Grants Commission has conferred Autonomous Status to the College of Social Work, Nirmala Niketan for a period of ten years w.e.f 2019-2020 to 2028-2029. With the Autonomous status we have started add-on credit courses such as Art Based Therapy, Basic Research Skills for grass root social workers, Advance research in qualitative and quantitative methods, Media and Communication, Social Entrepreneurships skills enhancing livelihood from 2019, which helps our students with additional skills in their professional career as Social workers.

In 2021 College ranked 91 among the colleges under autonomous status in India by the Education World and under the NIRF 2021 ranking by the Ministry of Education College of Social Work secured 71 rank. College of Social Work received prestigious National Educational Excellence Award as Top and Most Innovative College of the year 2021 (UG/PG Courses in Social Work) India Award under 'Quality Education, Overall Exposure to the students, Outstanding Administration and Social Contribution' Category for the year 2021 along with another award under the category Outstanding Performance in Virtual Knowledge Delivery during Pandemic by the Begin Up Intelligence Private Limited.

Inspite of the pandemic conditions our students were able to have good field work experience by online, offline and hybrid mode and have successfully completed the field practicum which will surely contribute in their future endeavors. 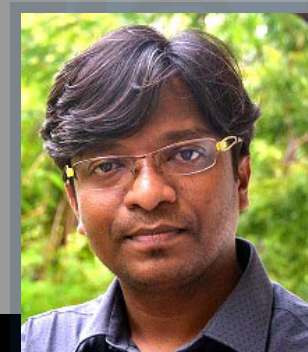

The programme, developed on a liberal arts paradigm enables students to use the full range of tools, theories and perspectives to understand, recognize, critique and appreciate themselves and their role in the globally dynamic environment. The district method of instruction (comprising andragogic and participatory teaching learning exercises) sets the tone for this strong foundation and helps the students to develop diverse, experiential, and practical knowledge. The graduates having been grounded in liberal arts and generalist social work perspectives can be employed in the government, NGOs, Social Movements, Hospitals, Social Enterprises, Cooperatives, International Development Agencies and CSR Projects, in capacities such as Community Organizers, Program Officers, Social Planners, Development Facilitators, and Social Welfare Administrators New syllabus under autonomy is implemented for MSW Sem I and II from the year 2019-2020.

The objectives of the MSW programme are as follows:

- To create critical understanding of social realities reflecting its changing nature and participate in the dynamics of change.
- To orient students on diverse population, their issues and social justice stance for social work practice.
- To equip the students with skills to work with different groups and communities using social work practice methods and strategies.
- To inculcate professional values and ethics that guide social work graduates in professional practice.

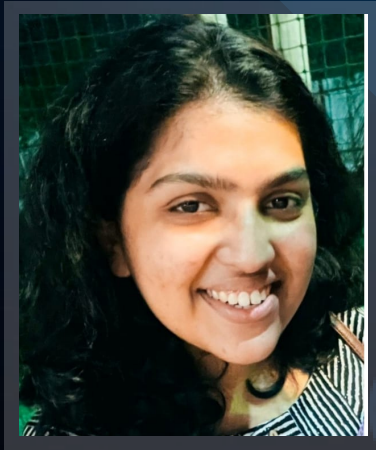
THE LIBRARY
