

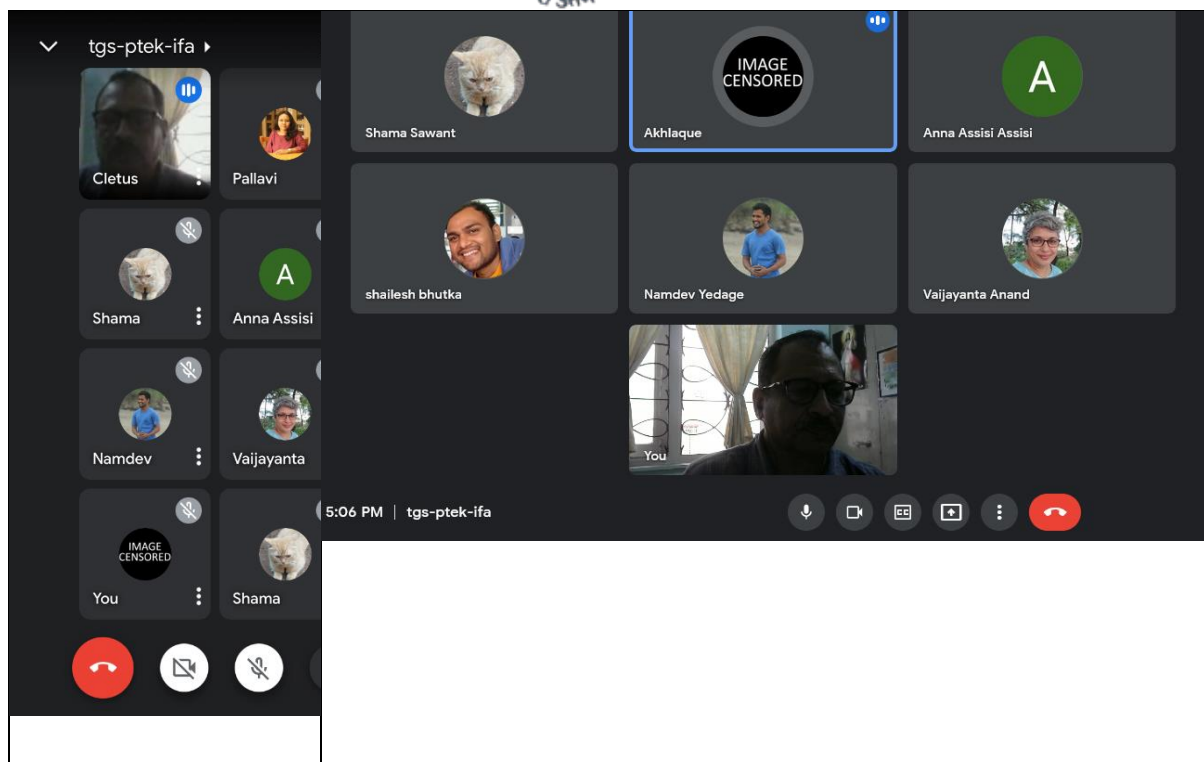

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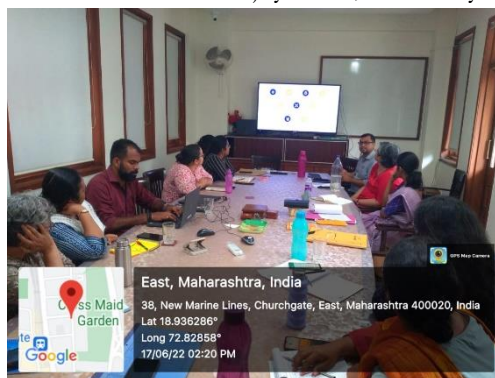


Sharing with Faculty – 17th June, 2022 – 12.30pm to 1.00pm

The afternoon session of the Faculty meeting held from 2pm to 3pm focussed on the IIC Activities planned and carried out by NCSIE. Dr. Ronald first began with an explanation on the NISP Policy adopted by the CSWNN. He then went on to explain about IIC and the various activities that were recommended by the IIC. Mr. Cletus shared on the activities carried out and also gave an update of the half yearly report and the marks given by the IIC on completion of the activities so far for 2021-22 till April.



The staff were appreciative of the work completed and the status awarded by the IIC.
