#### MSW II SEMESTER III

- 1. Students must report by 9:00 a.m. for the Research Vivavoce.
- 2. All students assigned to a Panel must be present during the presentations and report at 9.00 a.m. on both days, 6<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> October 2025. Students will be given 10 minutes to save their PowerPoint presentations on the laptop. Access to personal whatsapp on the system for downloading the Project A PowerPoint presentations will not be allowed. Hence, kindly ensure the PowerPoint presentations are saved on your pendrive to be carried along with you on the day of the Research Vivavoce.
- 3. Under no circumstances will the date/day of the Vivavoce be changed for any student.
- 4. The research student must carry a file with the following documents
  - Plagiarism/AI Content Verification Report obtained by the student between September 15th and 18th, 2025.
  - Copy of the Interview Schedule
  - Correspondence and feedback from experts on the tool
  - Consent forms obtained from the research participants
  - Attendance Track Record maintained by the student.
  - Data Collection Tool
  - Any other supplementary documents relevant to Chapters I and II
- 5. Each student has to present a 10-minute PowerPoint presentation of Chapters I and II based on the indicative template shared with all students.
- 6. The presentation will be followed by feedback and a question-and-answer by the Internal Examiners only.
- 7. Marking will be done as per the rubrics provided to the Internal Examiners
- 8. The total marks assigned for the Research Vivavoce is 50 marks.
- 9. Students are expected to wear their ID cards during the Research Vivavoce.
- 10. The Vivavoce Panels/Instructions have been displayed on the College Notice Board on the Ground Floor and will be uploaded on the website by 4<sup>th</sup> October 2025.
