

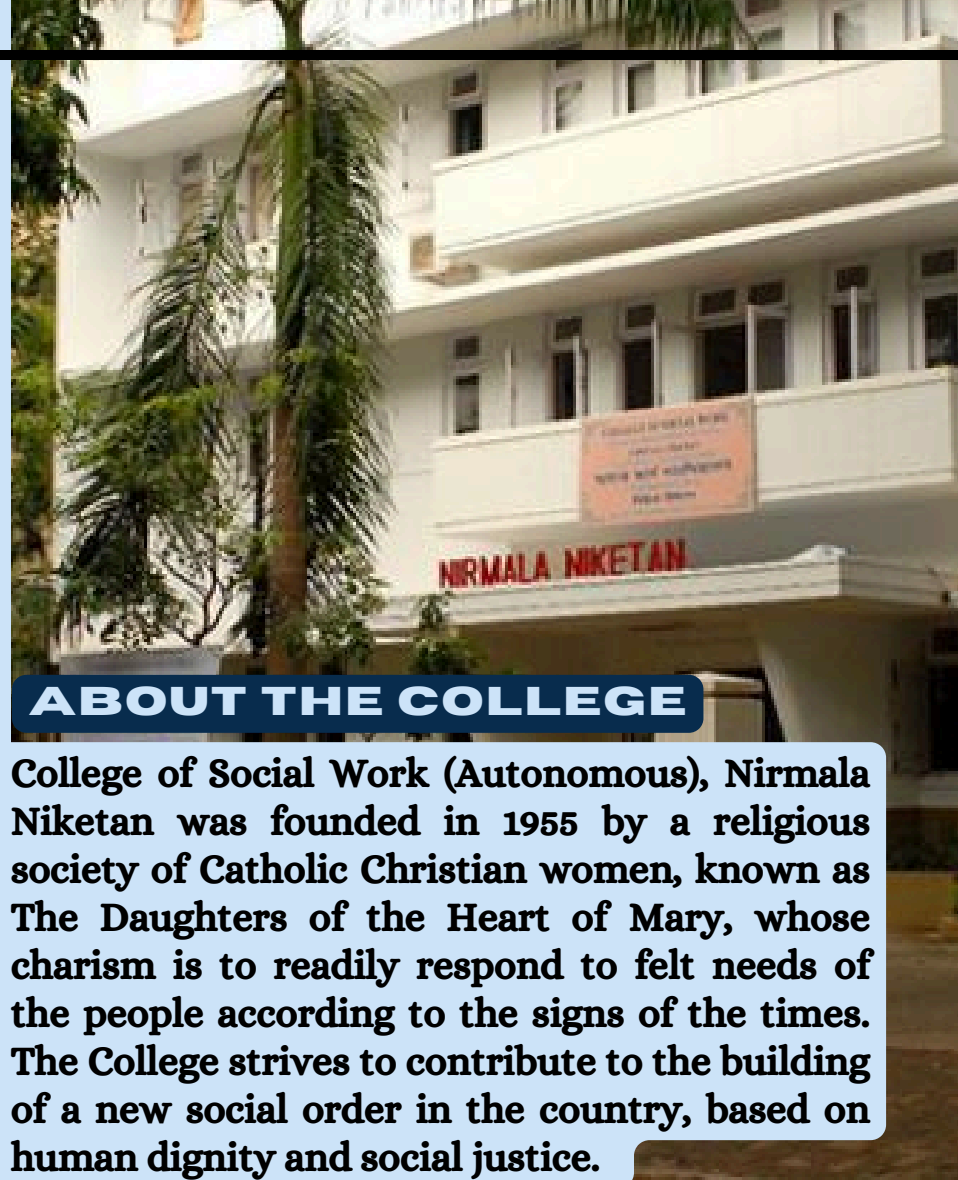
PGDRM
