Kindly Note

1. The course Assignments will require the student to demonstrate critical thinking via assimilation and synthesis of ideas when using credible, outside and course specific resources. References are **compulsory and should be based on the APA guidelines**. All sources from where material whether newspaper or magazine articles, books, papers, websites, the unpublished matter must be acknowledged in the Bibliography/references, etc. **“Plagiarism”** means the practice of taking someone else’s work or idea and passing them as one’s own”. For assessment of assignments, in which more there is more than 10 % of similarities with any referred source/sources, the guidelines as specified by the UGC (**Promotion of Academic Integrity and Prevention of Plagiarism in Higher Educational Institutions**) Regulations, 2018 will be applied.
1. Students are expected to take note of the dates of the given assignments sent by the Examination Committee. Assignment should be submitted to your subject teacher on due date by 5.00 pm.

2. **Absenteeism** on the submission date of the assignment will **not** entail a re-assignment and will lead to the student getting **nil** marks for the missed assignment unless the reasons are specified as per the Continuous Assessment Policy for non-submission of Assignments on the stipulated date and time.
